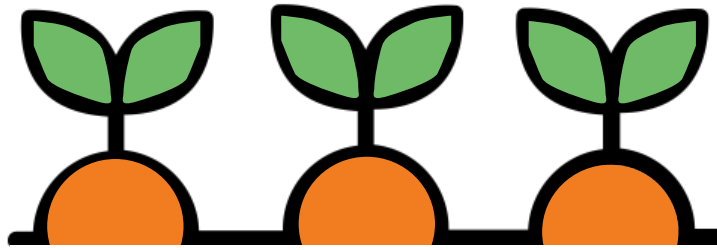


EWING COMMUNITY GARDENS CORONAVIRUS GUIDELINES 2021



In order to prevent the spread of the coronavirus and keep this garden and our gardeners safe, please follow these guidelines while in the garden.

STAY HOME IF YOU FEEL SICK.

Send a friend or fellow gardener to water your plot if you need to.

HAND WASHING

Wash or disinfect your hands **BEFORE** entering the garden. If you have hand sanitizer bring it with you.

TOOLS

Gardeners should regularly disinfect all communal tools and surfaces, and where possible gardeners should aim to use only their personal tools. We recommend bringing tools from home. When you use the wheelbarrow, hoses, or water spigot please wash or hand sanitize your hands before touching the tools. Wearing gloves will help.

HAND WASHING

Please wash your hands frequently, especially before and after touching the gates, water pump-shared tools, hoses, etc. We will not have paper towels at the garden, so air drying or wiping on the inside of your shirt is best.

GLOVES

Gloves do not replace proper hand sanitation procedures. The outside of your glove can transmit diseases from one surface to another, including transmitting the disease to yourself and others. It is a good idea to wear gloves while in the garden, but not a replacement for sanitation.

FACE MASKS

The CDC recommends wearing masks, especially when you might be close to others.

MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING

Community Garden members working in gardens should always observe safe social distancing by keeping a 6 foot distance from all people.
